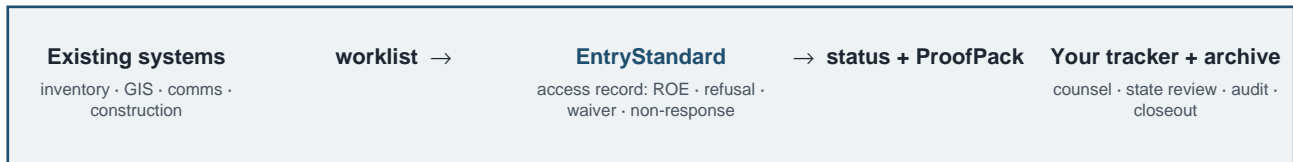


No rip-and-replace

How EntryStandard fits into an existing LSLR stack

EntryStandard is a sidecar access-record layer, not another LSLR platform. Your existing systems identify the line and manage the program. EntryStandard documents the access outcome — and returns it to you. There is no integration project for a pilot.



THE THREE-FILE MODEL

- Property worklist in — a CSV export from the current system.
- Access status out — ROE, refusal, waiver, non-response, attempt and method counts, crew-ready.
- ProofPack archive — per-property PDF, event ledger, document fingerprints, chain-verification result.

A PILOT NEEDS / DOES NOT NEED

- Needs: a worklist export, the approved ROE/refusal/waiver forms, outreach rules, a review contact, a status-export format.
- Does not need: replacing GIS, inventory, survey, or e-signature systems; migrating historical inventory; billing connections; or changing construction-management software.

DEPLOYMENT MODES

- Mock Access Audit — no integration; scorecard, gap memo, sample ProofPack.
- CSV pilot — no API; worklist in, status fields and ProofPacks out (250–500 properties).
- Status sync — scheduled export or API back to the program tracker, scoped after the CSV workflow proves useful.
- Embedded / OEM — the ES-R record engine inside an incumbent platform.
